

School and Bus Eligibility

Use our online tool to determine your home school and if your address is eligible for transportation. Addresses need to be within the school's boundary and a minimum distance from the school to be eligible for transportation. A school's acceptance of out-of-boundary registration does not mean transportation will be provided.

GRADE LEVEL	MINIMUM DISTANCE FROM SCHOOL	MAXIMUM DISTANCE TO STOP
JK-6	1.6KM	0.8KM
7-8	3.2KM	0.8KM
9-12	3.2KM	1.6KM

Apply for the School Bus by August 5, 2026

Students need to apply for the bus if:

- They are new to the school (ex: kindergarten students)
- They are changing schools (ex: new high school)
- Their address has changed, or they wish to add a second address

School registration is a separate process from applying for transportation. Families can apply for the school bus anytime and should do so before August 5, 2026 to ensure they have access to transportation on the first day of school in September.

Note: All riders must be registered for the bus. Families with multiple children need to apply for each student in order for them to be allowed on the bus.

Student Transportation Portal

Once your transportation application is processed, information will be available in the portal accessed through triboard.ca. Families will need to create an account to access information such as bus stop location, pick-up and drop-off times, bus route number, and the bus company operating the route.

Bus Delays & Cancellations

Bus status alert subscriptions can be managed through the portal. Buses can be delayed or cancelled for many reasons such as weather, traffic, staff shortages, etc. Families should consider back up methods of travel for their students when the bus is not available.
